#### **RESOLUTION NO. 02-2016**

# A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO FISCAL YEAR 2016 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that it is necessary at this time to appropriate money in all funds used by the Village of Perry, Ohio so that proper and necessary expenditures may be made; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has been further advised that said Permanent Appropriations for the Village's fiscal year 2016 shall not become affective until it has approved same; and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village that such Appropriations be authorized and approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That, effective the Lyth day of Longry, 2016, the Permanent Appropriations for the fiscal year 2016 of the Village of Perry, Ohio [as are more specifically set forth in Exhibit A, a wo (2) page document that is attached hereto and made a part hereof], are hereby approved and authorized.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to continually provide for the fair and prudent administration of Village affairs. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
