

RESOLUTION NO. 06 - 2015

**A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MARCH 2015,
AS PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH
IN THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO**

Whereas, Council has been advised that prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed non-skin cancer in men, and is the second leading cause of cancer deaths in men; and

Whereas, Council has been further advised that everyday another 630 American men learn that they have prostate cancer--230,000 a year—and every 18 minutes, a man dies from prostate cancer, and;

Whereas, Council has also been advised that during the early stages of prostate cancer there are no symptoms, thus, most prostate cancer is found through prostate cancer screening tests, and;


Whereas, Council has also been advised that all men are at risk for prostate cancer, and we are encourage the residents of the Village of Perry, Ohio to increase their awareness of the importance of prostate cancer screening.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That March, 2015, is hereby designated as PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH throughout the Village of Perry, Ohio.


