

RESOLUTION NO. 08-2016

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING COUNCIL MEMBER
MICHAEL GLOVER PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Perry, Ohio, has been advised that, pursuant to the provisions of Section 731.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, a President Pro Tempore of Council shall be elected at its first meeting in January of each year; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents of the Village Harbor to elect to said position an individual qualified and experienced in the management and administration of public affairs; and

WHEREAS, Council, having conducted a free and fair election from among its own members, has determined that Council Member, Michael Glover, should be designated as the President Pro Tempore of Perry Village Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 731.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, Council Member, Michael Glover, is hereby appointed the President Pro Tempore of the Council of the Village of Perry, Ohio, to serve until the first meeting of Council to be held in January, 2017, and shall be further granted all the powers, privileges and duties vested in him by law.


SECTION 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need for the efficient administration of Village affairs. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
