

RESOLUTION NO. 23-2015

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID AND AUTHORIZING
AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH RONYAK PAVING, INC.
FOR THE PAVING OF CENTER ROAD
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council has, pursuant to the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, previously authorized the advertising for bids for the Center Road Paving Project; and

WHEREAS, said bids were, as advertised, recently opened, reviewed and examined; and

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that the lowest and best responsible bid received for said Center Road Paving Project was from Ronyak Paving, Inc. in the amount of Three Hundred Two Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Six and 10/100 Dollars (\$302,746.10); and

WHEREAS, Council determines it is in the best interests of the Village to enter into an agreement with said company for the Center Road Paving Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the bid of the Ronyak Paving, Inc., for the performance of all work and services necessary to the completion of the Center Road Paving Project, is hereby acknowledged and declared to be the best, lowest, responsive and responsible bid after advertising in accordance with law.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Ronyak Paving, Inc., (that is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof) for the providing of all work, material and services that are necessary to, and constitute, the Center Road Paving Project for the amount of Three Hundred Two Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Six and 10/100 Dollars (\$302,746.10).

Section 3. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be, and is, passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to continually provide for the fair and prudent administration of Village affairs. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
