

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO, TO CERTIFY DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS TO THE LAKE COUNTY AUDITOR AND LAKE COUNTY TREASURER FOR COLLECTION AS PROPERTY TAX AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that monies are due the Village of Perry, Lake County, Ohio, for services provided in the performance of a lawn mowing upon the following respective properties:

Main St.
Perry, Ohio 44081
Permanent Parcel No. 04A-052-0-00-001-0
Owners of record -Fifth Third Bank
Amount Due \$ 900.00; and.

WHEREAS, statements for said services in the aforesaid amount of \$900.00 have been forwarded to the aforesaid respective owners of said properties and, to date, no payments have been received; and,

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that said delinquency be placed upon the tax duplicate to be assessed against the subject parcels of real property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Officer of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to certify to the Lake County Auditor and Lake County Treasurer for collection as property tax, those monies due the Village of Perry from those individuals and entities set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto and made a part hereof, same to be collected in tax year 20 14 as other taxes are collected.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to manage the financial affairs of the Village in a prudent and responsible manner. Said ORDINANCE is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry, Ohio.

Wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
