

VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-2015

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FIRSTENERGY SOLUTIONS CORP. ("FES") FOR STREET LIGHTING ELECTRICITY GENERATION REQUIREMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Perry wishes to purchase street lighting electricity generation requirements from FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. ("FES") through the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council ("NOPEC") endorsed street lighting program; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village to purchase street lighting electricity generation requirements FES through NOPEC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1. Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the Village, to purchase street lighting electricity generation requirements from FES through the NOPEC street lighting program.

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the agreement with FES for street lighting electricity generation requirements (the "Street lighting Agreement"). The FES Street lighting Agreement shall be substantially in the form presented to this Council and on file with the Clerk, subject to such changes, insertions and omissions which are consistent with this Ordinance and are not substantially adverse to the Village and as may be approved by the Mayor, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution of the Agreement.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to maximize the potential benefit through the NOPEC endorsed street lighting program with FES.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
