

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-04

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 738 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO, PERTAINING TO THE LICENSEING, INSPECTION, LOCATION, HOURS OF OPERATION AND GENERAL REGULATION OF SWEEPSTAKES TERMINAL (INTERNET) CAFES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has been advised of the need to provide for the continued update of those resolutions and ordinances of the Village necessary to the fair, proper and prudent management and administration of matters related to health, safety and well-being of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that Council amend the present Codified Ordinances of the Village to provide for such fair, proper and prudent management and administration of matters related to health, safety and well-being of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Council has been further advised that the regulations contained in Chapter 738 of the Codified Ordinances of Perry, Ohio, pertaining to The regulation of Sweepstakes Terminal (Internet) Cafes and its related and associated topic are no longer appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 738 of the Codified Ordinances of Perry, Ohio, presently reads as is set forth in the **three (3)** page document that is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village to repeal said Chapter in its entirety.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 738 of the Codified Ordinances of Perry, Ohio, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to provide policies, procedures and regulations necessary to insure the health, safety and well-being of the residents of the Village. Further, said Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry, Ohio.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
