

RESOLUTION NO. 02- 2015(R)

AN RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECT THE SALE AND/OR CREDIT VALUE OF SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the sale of personal property that is no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Said section further provides that upon authorization of Council, and upon approval by the officer, board or manager having supervision over same, said property, if the value of such is less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), may be sold without further action by said officer, board or manager; and

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code further provides for the sale of personal property that is no longer needed for municipal purposes if the value of said property is one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or more, and that upon the approval by the officer, board or manager having supervision over same, it may be sold after advertising in accordance with the provisions of said section; and

WHEREAS, Said section further provides that certain motor vehicles, equipment, machinery, etc. that are no longer needed by the municipal corporation (or that have become obsolete) may be used as credit against the purchase price of new motor vehicles, equipment, machinery, etc.; and

WHEREAS, Said section further provides that personal property having no value may be discarded or salvaged; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the Village to dispose of certain personal property in accordance with the respective provisions of the aforesaid Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That Council finds and determines it is in the best interests of the Village and it's residents to declare those items of personal property set forth in "Exhibit A" (same being attached hereto and made a part hereof) to be either of no further need to the proper management of the affairs of the Village, to be of some credit value to the Village in the purchase of other vehicles, equipment, machinery, etc. to be used by the Village, or to have no value other than scrap or salvage; and further, Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the interests of the Village and it's residents to authorize said property to be sold by internet auction (E-Bay, Craig's List, etc.) or in such other manner as shall be in accordance with the provisions of Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. This Council finds and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open

to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need for the fair and efficient administration of Village affairs. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
