

RESOLUTION NO. 05- 2016

A RESOLUTION CREATING AND ESTABLISHING
THE BOARD OF TAX REVIEW OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that Section 718.11 of the Ohio Revised Code provide for the creation of a Village Board of Tax Review, and the establishing of its powers and policies; and

WHEREAS, Council has been further advised that, in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Revised said Board shall consist of three members. Two members shall be appointed by Council, and one member shall be appointed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Council has also been advised that said Board shall be responsible for the hearing of tax appeals in accordance with the policies and procedures that shall be established as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the Village that said board be created and established.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That, pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of Section 718.11, of the Ohio Revised Code, there is hereby established and created "The Village of Perry Board of Tax Review."


Section 2. All formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need for the efficient administration of Village affairs. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
