

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2015**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER AND MAYOR TO ATTEND THE REQUISITE PUBLIC RECORDS TRAINING ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL AND MAYOR FOR THE CURRENT TERM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Perry is obligated, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 149.43(E) and 109.43 to have its designee undertake public records training in compliance with requirements established by the Attorney General for the State of Ohio; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, LAKE, OHIO, at least two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:


Section 1. The Village's Fiscal Officer and Mayor are hereby authorized to be the Village's designee for purposes of public records training as required by Ohio Revised Code Section 149.43(E) and 109.43, and to attend an approved training on behalf of the Village Council and Mayor, on March 31, 201 to be held in Columbus, Ohio.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action occurred in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village, since the resolution will need to go into effect prior to the public records training to be held on March 31, 2015; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
