

RESOLUTION NO. 44-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE REGIONAL INCOME TAX AGENCY (RITA) TO PROVIDE THE TAX AUTHORITY PORTAL (TAP) ASSISTANCE IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF INCOME TAX ORDINANCES AND OTHER SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has previously utilized the services of a third party vendor for the purpose of administering the income ordinances of the Village as well assisting and facilitating the collection of income tax due the Village; and,

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that there is an immediate need to continue to provide for such services through a new annual agreement with The Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA) and its Tax Authority Portal (TAP-a collection of computer application services); and,

WHEREAS, Council deems it to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Perry to provide for the uninterrupted continuation of said services, and enter into an agreement for same with The Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with The Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA), for the purpose of the utilization of its Tax Authority Portal (TAP-a collection of computer application services) in administering the income tax ordinances of the Village as well assisting and facilitating the collection of income tax due the Village, as is more specifically set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be, and is, passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to continually provide for the fair and prudent administration of Village affairs. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
