

RESOLUTION NO. 57-2015

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING TROY HAGER AS
CHIEF OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO, POLICE
DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that there is an immediate need to fill the position of Chief of Police of the Village of Perry, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, Council has been further advised that Troy Hager has demonstrated that he has the requisite qualifications, knowledge, training and experience to properly perform the duties and responsibilities required of one holding the position of Chief of Police of the Village ; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village has recommended to Council that said appointment be made; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the Village that said appointment be confirmed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That, effective January 1, 2016, Council hereby authorizes, directs, confirms and approves the appointment of Troy Hager as Chief of the Village of Perry Police Department; and, further authorizes, directs, confirms and approves, as a result of said appointment, that he shall receive all compensation, benefits, and privileges due him, and as shall be provided by this Council and the Ordinances of the Village of Perry, Ohio.


Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to manage the affairs of the Village in a prudent and responsible manner. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry, Ohio.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
